

The 1845-sq-ft apartment, bought by Deepika's firm KA Enterprises, is located in Sagar Resham Co-operative Housing Society and comprises 4 BHK and 5 BHK spaces as per documents accessed by Zapkey.com. The documents also suggested that the actress paid a stamp duty of nearly ₹1.07 crore and registration charges of ₹30,000.

Maps and mind-twisters

Ankon Mitra's current exhibition illustrates the ubiquitous act of folding, seen in everything from the genome of an entity to the sculpting of topography and the gush of oceans

aper folders are as critically all-embrac-ing as their approaches to the art. For Ankon Mitra, architect, origami artist and designer, crimps, pleats and petal folds are just some of the ways to create different shapes.

He exemplifies his solo exhibit at Kalakriti Art Gallery, in what curator Prashant Lahoti calls, "An esoteric joining of the cartographic with the geo-

metric."
Titled Maps Unfolded, precision is key, whether Ankon is folding a humble crane or a

complex modular struccomplex modular substance with interlocking parts. So is enthusiasm. The maps featured in this arrangement include traces of traditional Indian pilgrimage, printed bazaar, and city — each offering a window into the bygone are bygone era.

Ankon com-pares the pares Miura Map Folding Algorithm to nature how works. Miura solves the problem of maps tearing at their making them stronger. Similarly, nature uses mathematical principles, like folding, to make things more efficient, using less material and energy to create stronger struc-


years, I have been trying to do different stuff, in order to leave a mark on the audiences with the characters I portray on screen.
