### Mass shooting in Alabama

WASHINGTON (AP) — A mass shooting involving federal agents had left at least four people dead and dozens wounded in the US state of Alabama, police said on Monday.

"We believe this involves someone that normally works as a guard of people" in the Five Points South district of Birmingham, just after 11:30pm, police official Thomas Fitzgerald said from Atlanta.

Dozens of people were wounded in the shooting, with at least four requiring life-threatening injuries, Fitzgerald said.

Police are trying to provide as much information as they can to the public.

Several agencies are involved in the investigation, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

The rescue operation on the same Sunday night had continued off the site.

The police have been in at least 400 more shootings — defined as a shooting occurring in front of a business, that is considered a crime by the FBI — since 2019.

# Israeli strike hits Gaza; heavy fire with Hizbollah

GAZA CITY (Reuters) — Israeli forces on Monday struck a Hamas training camp in Gaza City, killing at least 10 people, including a senior Hamas military officer, and wounding dozens, according to Hamas.

The strike hit Rafi's Open House in a Hamas camp at Ras al-Ezayt (Rafid), the officials said. Among those killed was Ahmad Bahar, the director of the Palestinian Public Works and Housing Authority, they added.

His other Palestinian work killed in separate strikes in Gaza and southern Lebanon, the officials said. They said the number of Palestinians killed in Israeli strikes in the territories is 14,000, and Gaza's leader, Yahya Sinwar, said at least 100 people were killed in the strike, which he said was "a targeted strike" against Hamas military training camps.

Israel's demands for full control of the southern Gaza Strip and full Palestinian withdrawal from the Gaza Strip have been a major sticking point in efforts to conclude a cease-fire deal between Israel and Hamas.
