EMMYS 2024: DIVERSITY, INCLUSION AND SHOGUN!

The much-anticipated 76th Primetime Emmy Awards returned with a focus on recognising diverse voices in a pool of several talented actors and creators. The awards night, which took place in Los Angeles (US) on Monday, was particularly glorious for the ensemble of *Shogun* — a historical epic drama featuring warring dynasties in feudal Japan — as it took home 18 Emmys in a first-of-its-kind feat, beating a 16-year-old record set by the HBO mini-series *John Adams*. "We haven't even given out a single award tonight, and yet *Shogun* has already made Emmy history," remarked actor Dan Levy in the opening segment.

Liza Colon-Zayas, who plays a chef named Tina Marrero. Colon-Zayas beat industry giants Meryl Streep and Carol Burnett in the Best Supporting Actress category in a Comedy Series. "And to all the Latinas who are looking at me. Keep believing and vote. Vote for your rights," Colon-Zayas said during her acceptance speech.

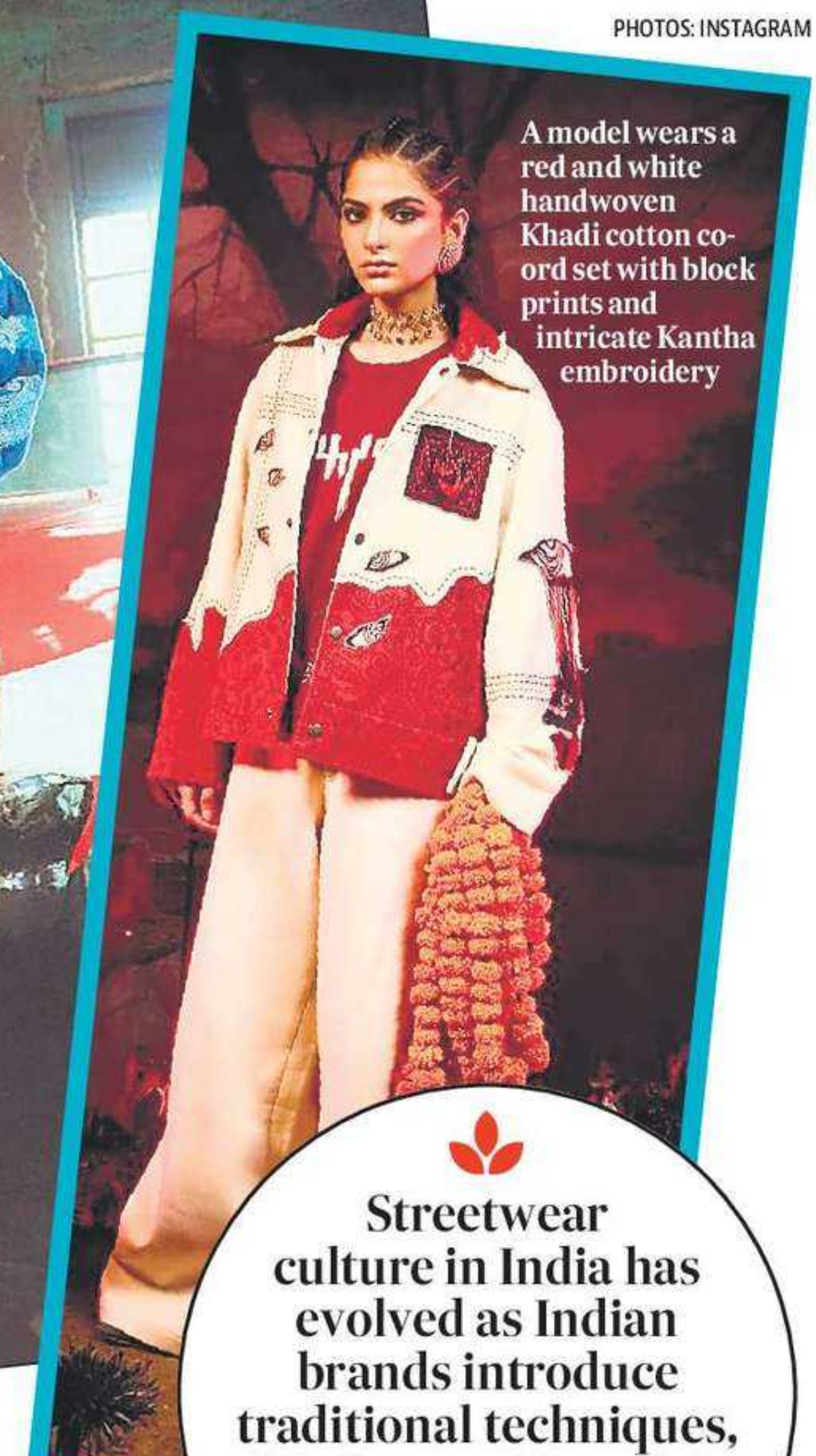

INDIAN STREETWEAR CELEBRATES LOCAL ART

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Streetwear style, known for its boxy silhouettes and neutral tones has always been steeped in popular culture. With designer Anamika Khanna's recent collaboration with a fast fashion brand, it is clear that Indian designers and new-age brands are taking over the streetwear scene, incorporating desi flourishes and collaborating with local artisans as they do so.

But how did street style become a celebration of local culture? This, designer Devesh Kothari explains, is because Indian streetwear is coming into its own. "Initially, streetwear was influenced by trends set by international brands. Now, homegrown brands are trying to fill the gap between [new-age fashion] and traditional dressmaking

techniques. By using techniques such as thread and bead work, dyeing, block printing, etc they're pushing the Indian streetwear culture to a global level," he says.

According to stylist Romi Choudhary, "Indian street staples have slowly become part of the runway. Brands like All You Can Street, Jaywalking and others were spotted at the recently concluded fashion weeks and are becoming celeb favourites. They're also worn by Gen Z influencers, which further cements their position." As a hypebeast or fashion-forward mentality grows among young people, the lines between street culture and luxury are beginning to blur. "From local thrift shops

to homegrown brands, Gen Z wants to tap into subcultures and celebrate local talent," designer Lakshmi Babu says, adding, "A recent Deloitte study showed that the streetwear market has grown up to ₹5.3 lakh crore in India in 2023. So it is no surprise that brands are coming up with better strategies, embracing Indian craftsmanship and keeping sustainability at their core."

But is such collaboration sustainable in the long run? Kothari agrees and says it has only just begun. "I feel there are many creative forces who can collaborate with international artists around the world to promote further Indian culture and heritage and further take it to a global stage."

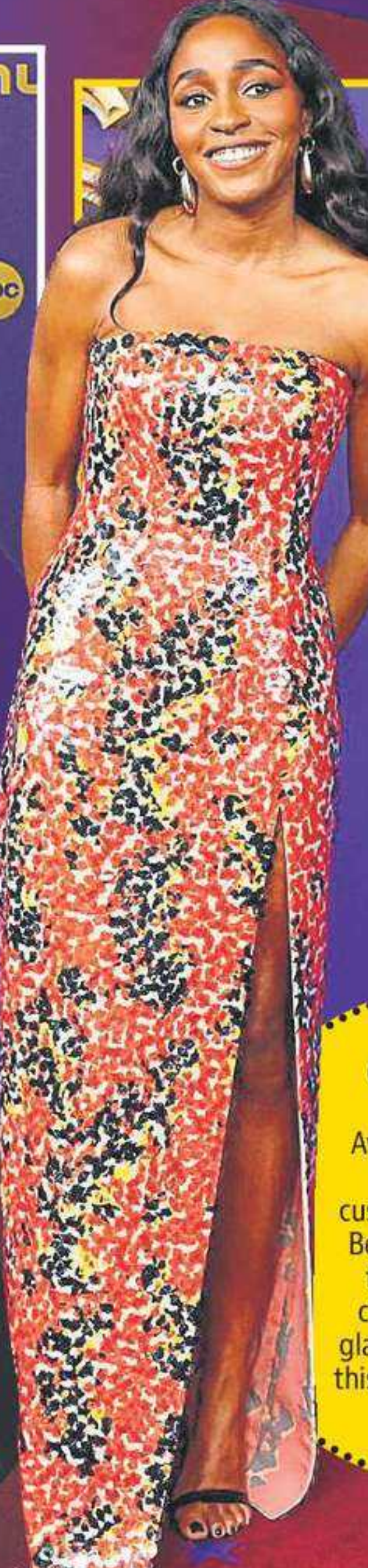
Emmy-nently stylish: The best dressed on the red carpet

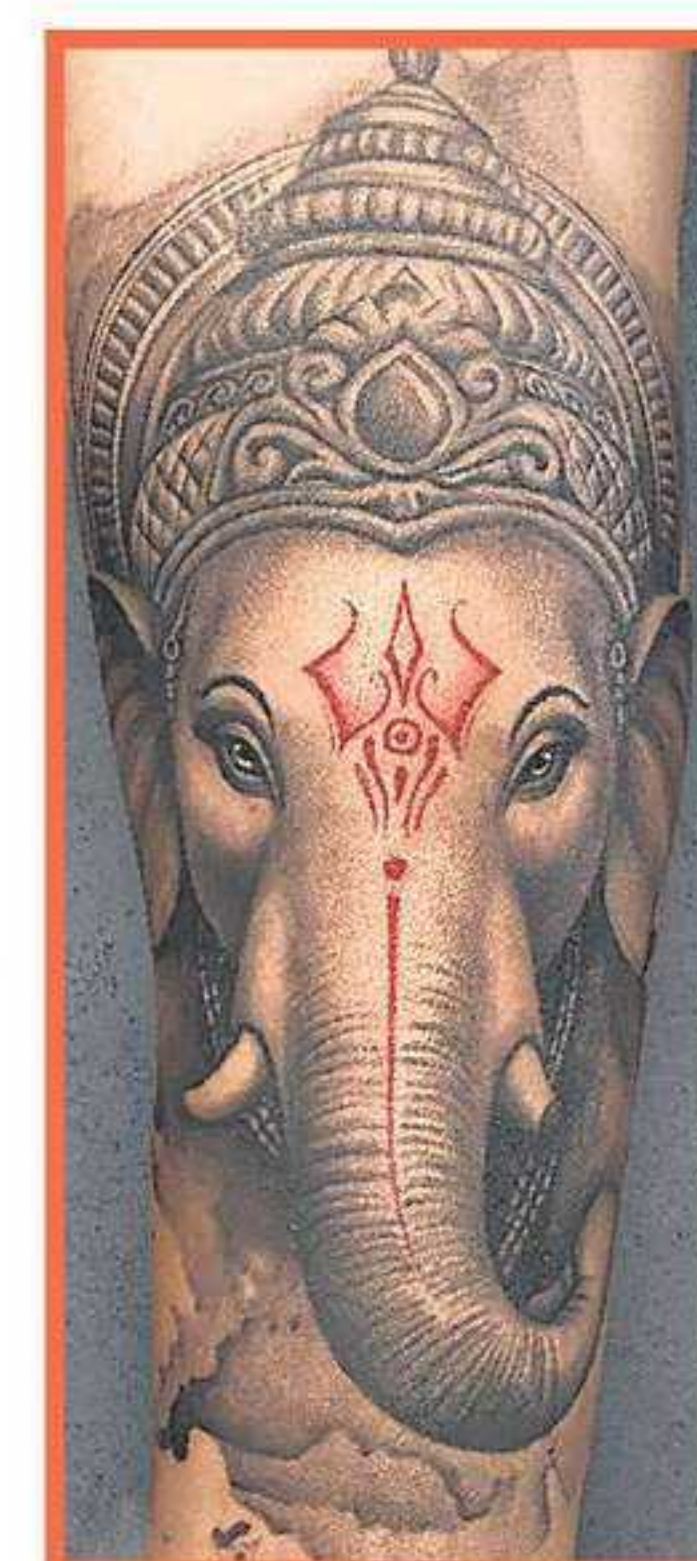

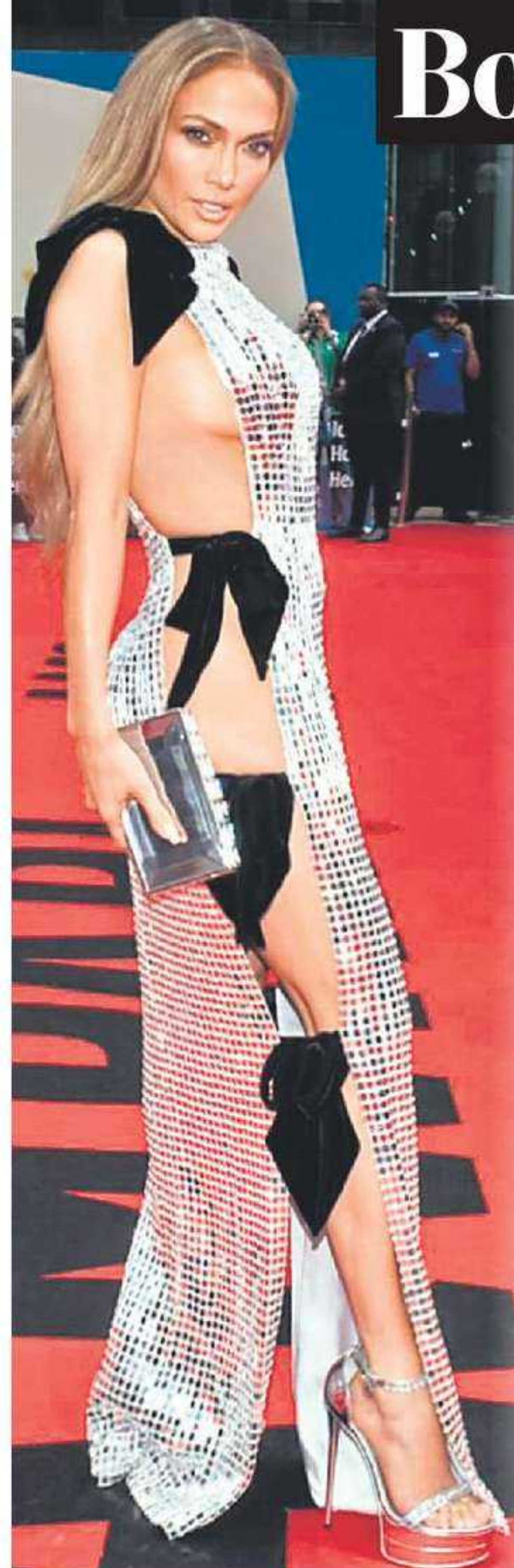

A lehsun in beauty: Why influencers are rubbing garlic on their face

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A peculiar new beauty trend has become the talk of social media — rubbing garlic on the face as a treatment for acne. Beauty influencers have also been chomping on raw garlic, claiming miraculous results. Is there any truth to these claims?

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Dr Agni Kumar Bose, dermatologist and dermatosurgeon pointed out that "there is limited scientific evidence to support the use of garlic on the face for skin benefits". While some studies suggest potential benefits for conditions like Alopecia Areata and corns, "the evidence for acne or other skin conditions is insufficient".

He warns that applying garlic directly to the skin can cause "irritation, burns, allergic reactions, and sensitivity", even in controlled

concentrations. Dr Amit Bangia, associate director of dermatology, Asian Hospital, shares that he has personally seen cases of "redness, skin irritation, burns, and even hyperpigmentation" as a result of using garlic on the face.

PROOFS OVER HACKS

Rather than opting for such

Several influencers claim that rubbing raw garlic cloves on the face is effective against acne

hacks, experts recommend consulting a dermatologist. Generally, acne-friendly products and a simplified skincare routine are advised. Dr Bangia advises against trying DIY remedies without scientific backing, especially when safer, clinically proven alternatives are available.

Given the lack of long-term studies, Dr Bose says, "There is

no scientific evidence to support the use of garlic for treating specific skin conditions." He further adds that over-the-counter ointments should also be used in proper concentrations. For instance, Tretinoin — a popular topical medication — is typically diluted to 0.025%. Uninformed choices can lead to severe consequences.

Aaj Ki Raat choreographer booked for sexual assault: Report

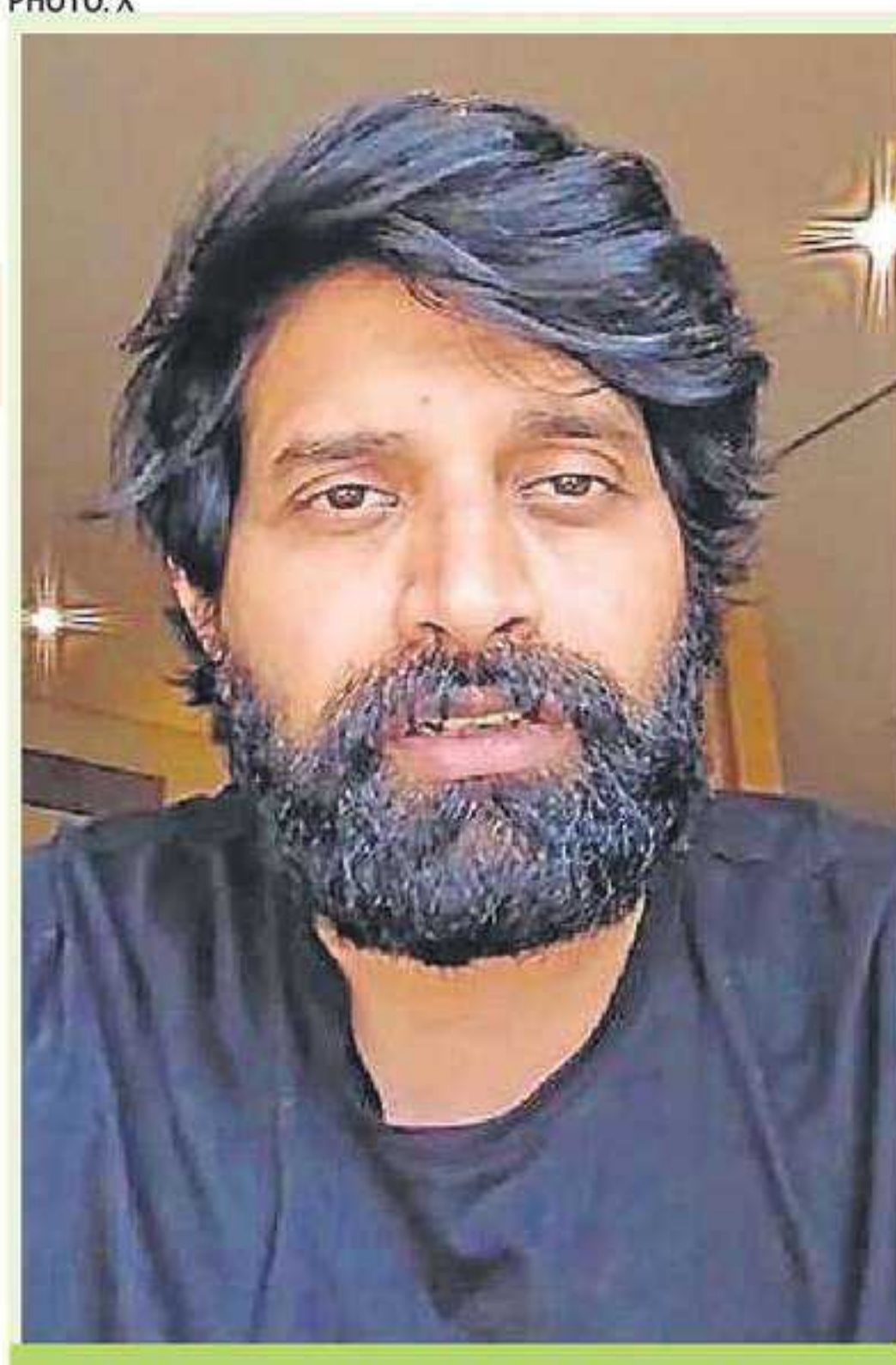

As per a report by The Hindu, a 21-year-old woman filed a complaint with the Raidurgam police in Hyderabad, stating that she is also a choreographer and a colleague of Master, and has been working closely with him for the past few months.

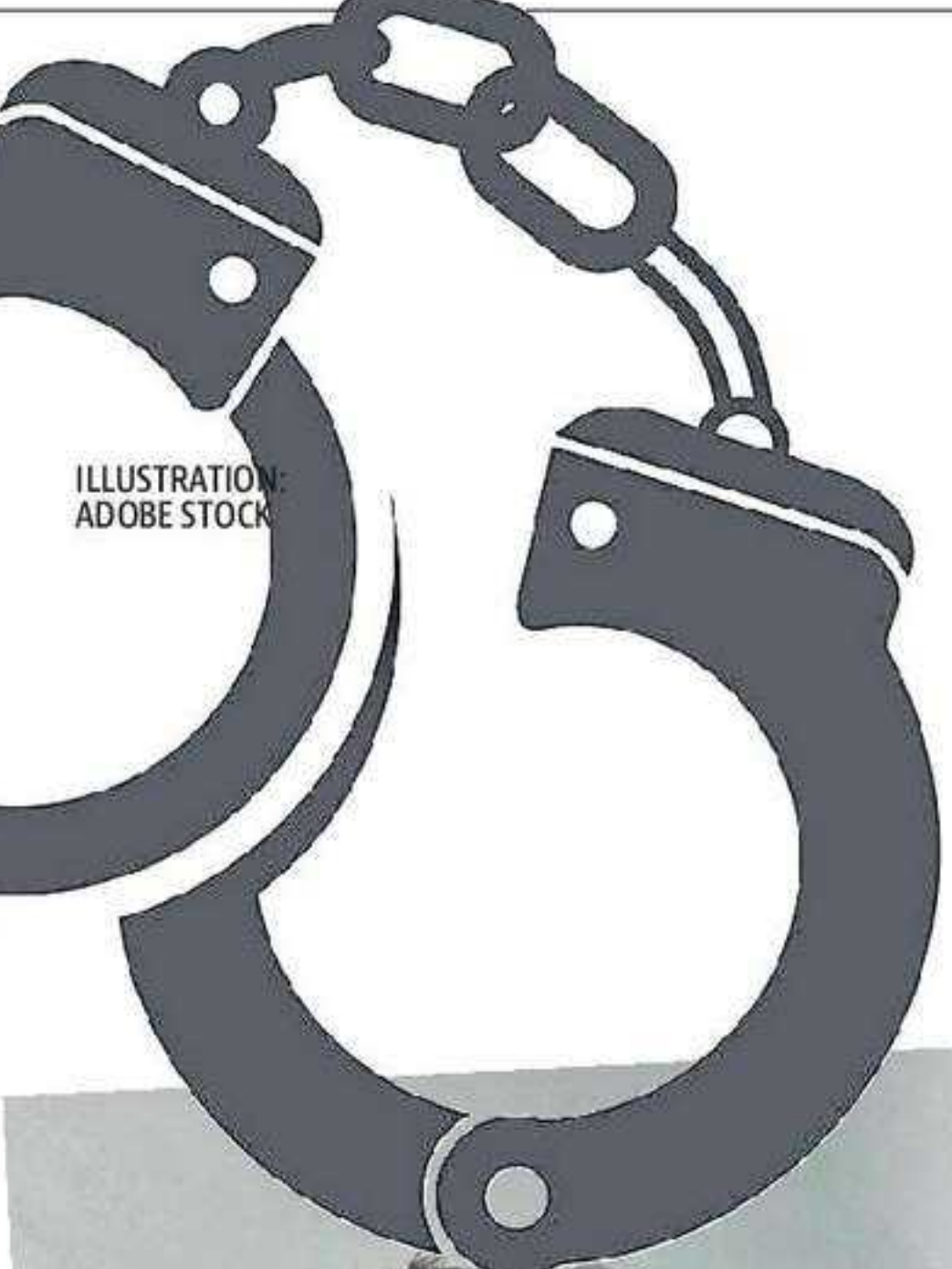

He was released after paying a bond of \$20,000.



GABRIEL OLDS
Actor Gabriel Olds was arrested on August 4 and charged with seven felony counts of sexual assault. The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) stated that Olds allegedly used his celebrity status and Ivy League education to exploit his victims, many of whom he met through dating apps. Olds, who currently resides in Los Angeles, is being held on \$3.5 million bail. The LAPD issued a press release stating that Olds was first accused of rape by a 41-year-old woman in January 2023, and a warrant for his arrest was issued on July 19.

SKAI JACKSON
Actor Skai Jackson was taken into custody on August 9 while she was in Universal Studios Hollywood for allegedly pushing her boyfriend twice. Law enforcement officials deemed her to be the primary aggressor in a supposed fight with her partner after reviewing camera footage. She was arrested in suspicion of domestic battery, but did not face any charges, as per reports.

JASON HOGANSON
Actor Jason Hoganson was sentenced to 18 months in prison for attacking his ex-girlfriend. Hoganson was found guilty of assault in relation to the incident, which took place on a public street. As per reports, Hoganson, who now has 109 convictions, was recorded by a doorbell camera during the attack on his former partner in Newcastle on December 11 last year. There was a restraining order against him at the time of the attack.

NICK PASQUAL
Actor Nick Pasqual, 34, was arrested in May after being charged with attempted murder for allegedly stabbing his former girlfriend, a make-up artist, multiple times at her Sunland home. The actor is said to have fled the scene but was later apprehended at a US-Mexico border checkpoint in Texas. The victim had recently obtained a restraining order against Pasqual, who broke into her residence around 4:30 am on May 23, inflicting several stab wounds.



HUNTER SCHAFER
Hunter Schafer, known for her role in the TV series *Euphoria*, was arrested at a pro-Palestine protest on February 26, amidst calls for a ceasefire between Israel and Hamas. Schafer, along with 50 activists from the Jewish Voice for Peace, was detained during a demonstration in New York. The protest was reportedly aimed at disrupting US President Joe Biden's appearance on a late night talk show to be filmed at NBC's 30 Rockefeller Center.
