France rally to back abortion

Hundreds of people rallied in defence of abortion rights yesterday in Paris and other cities in France - the first country to enshrine the right to abortion in its constitution.

Yesterday marked International Safe Abortion Day, with women's access to abortion remaining a precarious right globally, with numerous nations restricting or outlawing the procedure, while others ease access.

In March, French lawmakers voted to make terminating a pregnancy a "guaranteed freedom" in the constitution, a world first.

'Remain vigilant and united' amid regional tensions

Lt-General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah stated.

The Minister pointed out that this unity has reinforced Bahrain's deeply rooted values and has been crucial in overcoming various challenges.

Security and public order

His Excellency highlighted the admirable qualities that emerge from the Bahraini citizen during difficult times, such as a sense of responsibility for maintaining security and public order.

"Citizens are genuine partners in their duties towards their homeland," he remarked, emphasising that unity and a collective sense of responsibility

Six killed in chopper crash

A helicopter belonging to a Pakistan oil company crashed yesterday after suffering a technical fault during take off, killing six people, the Mari Petroleum Company (MPC) company said.

Fourteen people were on board including three Russian pilots and crew when it crashed in North Waziristan in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, near to the border with Afghanistan.

The injured have been taken to a military hospital for treatment.

Protesters call for UK to rejoin European Union

Several hundred people rallied in central London yesterday to call for the UK to rejoin the European Union which it left in 2020.

Protesters carried placards reading "Brexit is a monumental disaster" and chanting "rejoin" as they marched past the prime minister's Downing Street residence to gather in Parliament Square.

"With the new Labour government there's maybe a chance to begin reversing this mistake," academic Saskia Huc-Hepher, 50, whose husband is French, told AFP.

Watchful eyes

MPs propose centralised centre to ensure 'transparency and integrity'

The Parliament is preparing to discuss a proposal for the establishment of a National Centre for Oversight and Inspection during the upcoming session.

The proposal, submitted by MP Mohammed Al Rifaei, along with several other MPs, aims to have the government establish this new centralised body.

The explanatory memorandum accompanying the proposal highlights the need for a national centre to ensure transparency and integrity in oversight and inspection activities, protecting the rights of all parties involved.

A key argument for the center

Negative consequences

These negative consequences, he explained, include delays in issuing permits and disruptions to procedures. The centralisation of oversight functions is intended to address these issues.

The proposal is expected to generate significant debate in parliament, with its proponents arguing for increased efficiency and transparency in government operations.

Israeli strikes intensify

Over 50,000 flee Lebanon for safety in Syria

The UN refugee chief said yesterday that more than 50,000 people had fled to Syria amid escalating Israeli air strikes on Lebanon.

"More than 50,000 Lebanese and Syrians living in Lebanon have now crossed into Syria fleeing Israeli air strikes," Filippo Grandi said on X.

He added that "well over 200,000 people are displaced inside Lebanon".

A UNHCR spokesman said the total number of displaced in Lebanon had reached 211,319, including 118,000 just since Israel dramatically ramped up its

Israel has shifted the focus of its operation from Gaza to Lebanon, where heavy bombing has killed more than 700 people, according to Lebanon's health ministry, as cross-border exchanges escalated over the past week.

Most of those Lebanese deaths came on Monday, the deadliest day of violence since Lebanon's 1975-1990 civil war.

"Relief operations are underway, including by UNHCR, to help all those in need, in coordination with both governments," Grandi said.

Countdown to power

Tight battle for leadership roles in Parliament's Financial and Economic Committee

With the countdown to the third session of the Council of Representatives (2024-2025) beginning in about two weeks, intense competition is brewing for leadership positions within various parliamentary committees.

The spotlight is particularly focused on the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee, which is expected to be highly active during the upcoming session.

The committee will handle several crucial bills and projects, most notably the state's general budget, which will be debated between the legislative and executive branches.

Responsibility

The Financial Committee will be responsible for all related discussions within the Council.

Sources within the Council have confirmed that five out of the committee's eight members have expressed preliminary interest in vying for leadership positions – Chairman and Vice-Chairman – within the

According to these sources, a

new contender has entered the race for the chairmanship: MP Mohammed Al Maarefi.

Candidates

He will be competing against MP Mohammed Al Ahmed and MP Ahmed Al Saloum, the head of the Strategic Thinking Parliamentary Bloc. Both Al Ahmed and Al Saloum had previously held this position.

The sources also indicated that the current chairwoman, MP Zainab Abdulameer, has yet to declare her intentions regarding a re-election bid, although it's widely expected she won't seek a new term.

Her decision, or potential endorsement of another candidate, remains uncertain.

For the Vice-Chairman position, the sources revealed that the current Vice-Chairwoman, MP Eman Shuwaitar, and MP Mohammed Al Rifaei both intend to run.

Informal bloc

The sources further suggested that if MP Mohammed Al Ahmed secures the chairmanship, MP Mohammed Al Rifaei is likely to win the vice-chairmanship, as they reportedly form an informal bloc within the committee, along with other members.

However, if MP Ahmed Al Saloum or another candidate wins the chairmanship, the vice-chairmanship would go to a different MP.

Higher compensation joy for daughter's disability

A mother secured a significant legal victory after the Third High Court of Appeals increased her compensation from BD1,300 to BD2,000.

The compensation was awarded following a tragic traffic accident that left her daughter permanently disabled.

The court also determined that both the insurance company and the driver must cover legal fees and translation costs, affirming the family's right to compensation for the emotional turmoil inflicted by the incident.

Lawyer Zahra Naama, representing the victim's family, laid bare the harrowing circumstances surrounding the case.

The young woman suffered a permanent disability of 10% due to severe injuries to her left ankle and fractures in two bones of her heel, which required surgery. The driver was

found guilty in relation to the incident, leading the family to pursue legal action for both financial and moral redress.

Initially, the first-instance court ordered the insurance company and the driver to pay a total of BD5,300 to the plaintiffs, but it denied any compensation to the victim's mother.

Displeased with this outcome, the plaintiffs decided to appeal.

Naama has since called for a revision of the ruling, urging the court to compel the defendants to cover the victim's medical expenses resulting from the accident and to raise the compensation for each plaintiff to BD500, rather than the BD300 previously awarded by the first-instance court.

This case encapsulates the legal hurdles families face in their pursuit of justice, revealing the emotional and financial strains they must navigate in the aftermath of such life-changing events.

National Ambulance handles 160 daily emergency situations

Every day, as sirens wail 160 times across Bahrain, paramedics leap into action, racing to save lives from the brink.

From battling life-threatening heart attacks to navigating the chaos of car crashes, the National Ambulance's 12 stations serve as a critical lifeline.

Yesterday, Captain Saleh Al Faihani opened a window into this high-stakes world on 'Amn FM,' revealing the intense pressures and unexpected challenges faced by his team.

The National Ambulance's crucial role was showcased on 'Amn FM,' a radio programme produced by the General Directorate of Media and Security Culture in collaboration with Bahrain Radio.

Realities

Captain Al Faihani, an officer from the operations room, took the opportunity to elaborate on the realities faced by his team.

He explained that the 12 ambulance centres are strategically placed throughout all governorates of the kingdom, their locations determined by thorough geographical studies and population data.

On average, these centres manage approximately 160 emergency calls each day.

Extensive training

He assured listeners that paramedics receive extensive training to prepare them for the demanding nature of their

work, equipping them to provide high-quality emergency care.

Captain Al Faihani went on to describe the swift response capabilities of the service.

Call handlers are trained to deal with a wide range of communications, including calls from individuals with special needs.

Translation support

They are proficient in several languages, such as English, Hindi, and Filipino, and when the situation calls for it, they collaborate with external agencies, including embassies, for translation support.

He urged drivers not to block emergency vehicles after they have passed, emphasising that quick movement is crucial for ensuring safety and preventing further accidents.

He also stressed the importance of adhering to the instructions given by call handlers, as these can be vital in stabilising patients and preserving lives.

Fishing for solutions

Barbar fishermen demand long-overdue port, propose urgent safety measures and clean-up

Fishermen in Barbar are facing theft and hazardous waterways, calling for urgent action to safeguard their livelihoods and ensure safe access to the sea.

"Every time I set out, I wonder if my boat will still be there when I return," said Jameel Shuaib, a fisherman who has incurred substantial losses due to stolen gear. "The sea is already risky enough without the added worry of thieves."

Local fishermen are demanding safety measures, citing frequent theft of boats and equipment alongside dangerous conditions in the local waterways.

They are urging the installation of security cameras to protect their assets and express frustration over ongoing neglect. Their requests include cleaning the marine channel and improving access roads to the pier.

They also insist that the government acquire land along the western coast near their jetty, which has remained uncleared despite years of appeals.

Primary source of income

Many residents of Barbar depend on fishing as their primary source of income.

Shuaib, representing the local committee, noted that requests for cleaning the marine channel have been ongoing for over a decade.

Despite promises to launch the project as early as 2007, plans have yet to materialise.

"We continue to receive assurances, but it is time to take action and stop delaying this project," Al Shuwaikh insisted.

He emphasised the need for clean and well-maintained coastlines as part of Bahrain's sustainable development goals.

Proposal

In 2021, a proposal to clean the waterway was submitted to the Northern Municipal Council but has since stalled, with no movement from the responsible agencies.

The channel remains filled

with rocks and marine debris, and illegal land reclamation has worsened the situation.

"Today, the fishermen cannot access the coast, putting their livelihoods at risk," Al Shuwaikh said, urging immediate action to restore the channel and facilitate safe passage for boats.

Ali Jawhar, a fisherman and resident of Barbar, called for the establishment of a 'Bandar' (fishermen's port) in the area, highlighting the long-standing connection between Barbar's economy and the sea.

"Many families here rely solely on fishing for their income," Jawhar said.

He expressed frustration over

the lack of action from authorities, despite numerous meetings and promises.

Jawhar directly appealed to His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, urging them to prioritise the acquisition of land near the fishermen's jetty and ensure local fishermen receive the necessary support.

Northern Council Chairman Dr Shubbar Al Wadaei told The Daily Tribune, "The council has maintained a close relationship with local fishermen since 2018, working to develop solutions within legal frameworks."

He noted that a formal memo outlining the fishermen's demands was submitted to the council, resulting in the approval of a proposal to clean the Barbar channel, which was forwarded to the Ministry of Agriculture and Marine Resources.

However, Al Wadaei criticised the lack of action from the ministry despite repeated requests for a meeting with the relevant authorities.

He called for immediate intervention by the responsible agencies to address the blockage of the channel with mud and rocks, which remains a serious safety concern for fishermen.

Prices for next Hajj season campaigns

Ten licensed campaigns have officially announced their prices for the upcoming Hajj season (1446 AH - 2025 AD).

Of these, three campaigns have set their prices starting at BD1,490 and BD1,555, although they have not provided details regarding the specifics of the trips or the duration of stays.

Additionally, four other campaigns have outlined travel dates via land and air but have not disclosed their prices. Approximately 40 campaigns are expected to announce their offerings soon.

According to the currently announced prices, the lowest fare has decreased to BD500, while the highest price for a 19-day Hajj package has reached BD2,350.

The cheapest package available currently starts at BD1,490, again without detailing the specifics of the trips.

The trips are scheduled to commence on May 23, 2025, with the last departure for participants set for May 31. Return flights after the Hajj season, including a visit to Medina, are planned for June 10, 2025.

Moody's downgrades Israel credit rating on high 'geopolitical risk'

Ratings agency Moody's downgraded Israel's credit rating Friday, citing heightened geopolitical risks as its conflict with Hezbollah worsened and prospects for a ceasefire in Gaza



receded.

"The key driver for the downgrade is our view that geopolitical risk has intensified significantly further, to very high levels," said Moody's in a statement.

This came as it shifted Israel's ratings down two notches from A2 to Baa1, marking its second downgrade this year.

Fitch and S&P Global Ratings have also lowered Israel's rat-

ings this year.

Moody's noted that the risks had "material negative consequences for Israel's creditworthiness in both the near and longer term."

Israel shifted its focus from the war in Gaza to Lebanon this week, pounding Hezbollah strongholds around the country and killing hundreds of people.

A day after its Palestinian ally Hamas staged an unprecedent-

ed attack on Israel on October 7, Hezbollah started fighting Israeli troops along the Lebanon border.

"Longer term, we consider that Israel's economy will be more durably weakened by the military conflict than expected earlier," Moody's said on Friday.

It noted that the intensity of conflict between Israel and Hezbollah has "increased materially over recent weeks, with a further severe escalation a possibility."

"At the same time, prospects for a ceasefire in Gaza have receded," Moody's added.

The agency also said "there is no visibility on an exit strategy from the military conflict that would restore a level of certainty and security, on which the economy and business investment ultimately rely."

EU recommends airlines avoid Lebanese, Israeli airspace

Paris, France

Airlines should avoid Lebanese and Israeli airspace for the coming month, the European Union said Saturday, amid an escalation in air strikes and rocket fire between Israel and Hezbollah.

The European Commission and European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) warned in a statement of "an overall intensification of air strikes and degradation in the security situation".

They issued an official recommendation "not to operate within the airspaces of Lebanon and Israel at all flight levels".

Provisionally lasting until October 31, the Conflict Zone Information Bulletin (CZIB) "can be reviewed earlier and adapted or withdrawn", the statement added.

"EASA will continue to closely monitor the situation, with a view to assess whether there is an increase or decrease of risks for EU aircraft operators as a result of the evolution of the threat," the body said.

Israeli bombardment of the southern outskirts of Beirut on Friday hit its highest intensity since the state's last war with Hezbollah in 2006.

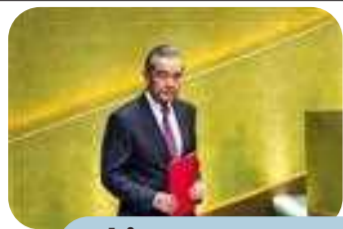

China's Foreign Minister Wang Yi warned on Saturday against the expansion of the conflict in Ukraine, which has accused Beijing of assisting Russia in its war. Kyiv has been particularly scornful of Beijing's calls for talks to resolve the conflict, but Wang reiterated China's offer to help broker an end to fighting. "The top priority is to commit to no expansion of the battlefield, no escalation of fighting, and no provocation by any party, and push for de-escalation of the situation as soon as possible," he told the UN General Assembly. "China is committed to playing a constructive role, engaging in shuttle mediation and promoting talks for peace, not throwing oil on the fire or exploiting the situation for selfish gains." Wang also called for an immediate ceasefire in the fighting between Israel and Hamas in Gaza, but only noted the resumption of fighting in Lebanon without commenting on the death of Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah, who was killed in an Israeli strike.

South African police said yesterday they were launching a manhunt after 17 people were shot dead in a town in the east of the country. "In one house, 13 people were killed -- 12 women and one man. In another, four people were killed. An 18th victim is in critical condition in a hospital," the police said in a statement. South African media said the mass shootings occurred Friday night in the town of Lusikisiki in the Eastern Cape province about 200 kilometres (125 miles) southwest of Durban. "We do not know the motive" and "we do not know if there is one or several suspects on the run", national police chief Fannie Masemola said on SABC

Trump vows to prosecute Google for showing 'bad' stories on him



Donald Trump on Friday accused Google of showing only "bad stories" about him and vowed to have the tech giant prosecuted if he gets back in the White House. Trump provided no backing for his accusation in a post on his Truth Social platform, in which he added that the search engine displays only positive articles about his Democratic rival Vice President Kamala Harris. "This is an ILLEGAL ACTIVITY, and hopefully the Justice Department will criminally prosecute them for this blatant Interference of Elections," he said in the post. "If not, and subject to the Laws of our Country, I will request their prosecution, at the maximum levels, when I win the election." The Trump post came after a conservative group reported on what it said it found when doing a search on "Donald Trump presidential race 2024."

SpaceX set to launch mission to return stranded astronauts

A SpaceX mission is set for launch Saturday with two passengers on board, leaving two seats empty to return the American astronauts who have been stranded for months on the International Space Station, NASA said. The launch of the Falcon 9 rocket is scheduled for 1:17 pm (1717 GMT) from Cape Canaveral, Florida. It will use a new launch pad, the pad's first use for a crewed mission. On board will be NASA astronaut Nick Hague and Russian cosmonaut Alexander Gorbunov.

When they return from the space station in February, they will bring back the two space veterans -- Butch Wilmore and Suni Williams -- whose stay on the ISS was prolonged for months by problems with their Boeing-designed Starliner spacecraft. The newly developed Starliner was making its first crewed flight when it delivered Wilmore and Williams to the ISS in June. They were supposed to be there for only an eight-day stay, but after problems with the Starliner's propulsion system emerged during the flight there, NASA was forced to weigh a radical change in plans.

Hezbollah chief Hassan Nasrallah has been killed, the Lebanese movement said yesterday, dealing a seismic blow to the Iran-backed group that has been engaged in a year of cross-border hostilities with Israel. Hezbollah's statement came after Israel's military said it had killed Nasrallah in an air strike on Beirut's southern suburbs, in a move that could destabilise Lebanon as a whole.

Iran, which arms and finances Hezbollah, said a senior member of its Revolutionary Guard Corps was killed in the same strike. "Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah, Secretary General of Hezbollah, has joined his great, immortal martyr comrades whom he led for about 30 years," Hezbollah said in a statement. It said he was killed with other group members "following the treacherous Zionist strike on the southern suburbs" of Beirut.

AFP journalists heard a passer-by scream "Oh my God!", and women weeping in the streets after Hezbollah announced the news. Rarely seen in public, Nasrallah had

Storm Helene kills 44, threatens more 'catastrophic' flooding as cleanup begins

Cedar Key, United States

Millions of Americans were still without power and many faced torrential flooding on Saturday, authorities said, as powerful storm Helene rumbled across eastern and mid-western US states, leaving at least 44 people dead. At least 19 people died in South Carolina, 15 in Georgia, seven in Florida, two in North Carolina and one in Virginia, according to updated reports from local authorities tallied by AFP. Repair crews were already at work after Helene slammed into Florida late Thursday as

erful winds of 140 miles (225 kilometers) per hour. Even as a weakened post-tropical cyclone, it has wreaked havoc. Record levels of flooding threatened to breach dams, with one dam in Tennessee on the verge of failure, authorities said, urging residents to move to higher ground.

Massive flooding was reported in Asheville, a city in western North Carolina. Governor Ray Cooper called it "one of the worst storms in modern history" to hit his state. In Cedar Key, an island city of 700 people just off Florida's northwest coast, the full destructive force of the hurricane

was on view. Several pastel-colored wooden homes were destroyed, victims of record storm surges and ferocious winds. In South Carolina the dead included two firefighters and six residents of Spartanburg County, officials said.

Georgia Governor Brian Kemp's office confirmed 15 deaths in his state, including an emergency responder. Governor Ron DeSantis of Florida said the damage from Helene exceeded that of hurricanes Idalia and Debby, which both hit the same region south-east of Tallahassee in the last 13 months.

59 dead in Nepal as downpours trigger floods

Floods and landslides triggered by heavy downpours in Nepal killed at least 59 people across the Himalayan country, with rescue teams searching for 44 missing, police said Saturday. Rain-related disasters are common in South Asia during the monsoon season from June to September, but experts say climate change is increasing

their frequency and severity. Large swathes of Nepal have been inundated since Friday, prompting disaster authorities to warn of flash floods in multiple rivers. "So far, there are 59 dead, 36 wounded and 44 missing," Nepal police spokesman Dan Bahadur Karki told AFP. Karki said more than 200 incidents of flood and landslides have been reported and that the toll was likely to increase further.

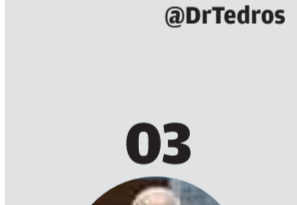

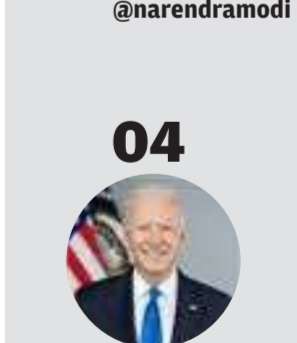

Ensuring Road Safety in Bahrain

I have been living in Bahrain for the past 26 years, and in my view, it is the most beautiful country in the world. My children were born and raised here, and have studied here all their lives.

When I first came to Bahrain, the population was hardly around 1.2 million. There were no malls, no parks, nothing—but look at how rapidly it has grown! Back then, people used to drive very carefully and slowly. However, in recent years, traffic has significantly increased, and now it seems everyone is in a hurry to go—where, I do not know. Unfortunately, this rush is leading to a rising number of fatal accidents, despite the installation of cameras to monitor speeding and red-light violations.

I have also noticed children leaning out of car windows, which has caused tragic incidents of children falling out, resulting in injuries, permanent disabilities, or even death. Who is to blame for these avoidable tragedies? Is it the drivers or the parents? To make matters worse, these incidents occur while the vehicles are moving at speeds of up to 100 km/h. Despite repeated warnings from traffic officers, many drivers still fail to follow basic safety rules. Children continue to sit on the front seat or, shockingly, on the driver's lap—whether it's the mother or the father—completely disregarding the dangers. Sudden braking can easily cause injury to the child.

I would like to request the authorities to take strict action against drivers who allow their windows to remain open while driving, especially when children are in the car. Furthermore, children sitting in the front seat should be strictly prohibited and drivers fined for violating this rule. In some countries, even members of the public are allowed to take pictures of drivers with children in unsafe positions and send them to the traffic department. A similar measure could be adopted here in Bahrain.

I believe that if such initiatives are implemented, we can reduce the number of accidents and injuries, making our roads safer and allowing us all to drive with greater peace of mind. God bless this nation and keep it safe.

A bill seeking to tie the validity of the Central Population Registry (CPR) card to residency duration has encountered resistance from the government, which maintains that existing laws adequately address the issue without the need for new legislation.

New 'grumpy' fish species discovered in the Red Sea



A new type of fish described as "grumpy" by scientists has been found in the Arabian Red Sea.

The species - scientifically named *sueviota aethon* - has been dubbed the grumpy dwarfgoby by researchers who found the fish among coral reefs in the sea, living in small holes and crevices.

In a study published last week, researchers said the name "refers to the fish's apparent grumpy and rather unhappy appearance, primarily due to the extremely upturned mouth position".

An 8-year-old Ohio girl drove an SUV on a solo Target run

BEDFORD, Ohio (AP) — An 8-year-old girl took an SUV from her Ohio home and drove for miles to a store where she was later found unharmed, authorities said.

The girl, whose name was not released, and the vehicle — a 2020 Nissan Rogue — were reported missing around 9 a.m. Sunday, Bedford police said. Family members said they had last seen the girl at the residence about two hours earlier. As police launched an investigation, they learned a small child had been spotted driving a vehicle on a nearby road, but that vehicle could not be located. The SUV eventually was found a short time later in the parking lot of a Target store in Bainbridge, which is nearly 13 miles (21 kilometers) from her home.

Police soon found the child by herself inside the store. She told officers she had struck a mailbox while driving, but nothing else. Authorities did not say why she had decided to travel to the store or provide further details about her trip. The girl is too young to be charged criminally, police said. It wasn't clear Monday if any charges would be filed in the matter, which remains under investigation.

Bagnaia halves Martin's MotoGP lead with Indonesia sprint win

Francesco Bagnaia won a dramatic Indonesia MotoGP sprint race yesterday, capitalising on an early crash by championship leader Jorge Martin to halve the Spaniard's lead to 12 points at the top of the standings.

Pramac rider Martin slid off on the first lap to gift reigning champion Bagnaia the race lead in a blow to his championship hopes with Sunday's grand prix and five race weekends to go.

"Everybody knows how important it was to gain points, we gained 12 (points). So thanks to the mistake of Jorge, we are close again," Bagnaia told reporters.

Bagnaia's teammate Enea Bastianini finished second, while six-time MotoGP champion Marc Marquez of Gresini completed the podium in third. Martin had secured pole position

at the sweltering Mandalika a lap record in qualifying but track on Lombok island with could only claw his way back

to 10th place after the costly incident.

A win in the sprint would have guaranteed Martin the championship lead heading into next week's Japan MotoGP, the first of five remaining race weekends in the 2024 season.

Bagnaia can now overtake Martin in the championship depending on results in Sunday's GP.

Bastianini battled with Marquez for second place but held on to finish behind his teammate.

The Italian rider, who will be replaced by Marquez at Ducati's factory team next season, is 50 points behind Martin ahead of Sunday's GP.

"I am happy. After I bring my pace and levelled up, I was a bit faster. In the last lap I tried to catch Pecco (Bagnaia) but the gap was important. The second position is okay," Bastianini told reporters.

No Pant as India name T20 squad

James Justin reduced the deficit with a deflected 47th-minute effort and stunned the Emirates Stadium into silence in the 63rd minute when his thunderous volley cannoned in off the woodwork.

But Mikel Arteta's men stole the points four minutes into stoppage-time when Trossard's shot deflected off Leicester's Wilfred Ndidi for an own goal, with Kai Havertz netting moments later to confirm the victory.

Palmer runs riot

Palmer became the first player ever to score four goals in the first half of a Premier League match with a stunning display at Stamford Bridge.

Former Brighton duo Moises Caicedo and Robert Sanchez were guilty of mistakes when Georginio Rutter put the Sea-

gulls ahead in the seventh minute.

Just moments after hitting the post and then having a goal disallowed, it was third time lucky for Palmer in the 21st minute.

Palmer equalised with a clinical finish after Nicolas Jackson seized on Adam Webster's mistake to tee up his fellow forward.

When Jadon Sancho was tripped in the area by two Brighton defenders, there was never any doubt that penalty expert Palmer would step up to dispatch the 28th-minute spot-kick with ease.

Palmer completed his nine-minute-and-48-second treble in the 31st minute, curling a brilliant free-kick past Bart Verbruggen from 25 yards to make it five goals in six league games this term.

Carlos Baleba pulled one back in the 34th minute, but Palmer's incredible afternoon wasn't over and, in the 41st minute, the England star converted Sancho's pass with an emphatic strike.

West Ham midfielder Tomas

Soucek rescued a 1-1 draw at Brentford, who made Premier League history thanks to Bryan Mbeumo's quick-fire opener.

Under-fire Hammers boss Julen Lopetegui saw his side fall behind after just 37 seconds as Mbeumo's superb volley made Brentford the first Premier League team to score in the first minute in three consecutive games.

But Soucek swept in West Ham's 54th-minute equaliser to avoid a fourth defeat in their last five games in all competitions.

Dwight McNeil struck twice in the second half as Everton beat Crystal Palace 2-1 to end their winless start to the league season, just days after the Goodison Park takeover by a group led by American billionaire Dan Friedkin.

Raul Jimenez's 51st-minute penalty gave Fulham a 1-0 win at Nottingham Forest.

Liverpool will go top of the table if they win at Wolves in Saturday's late game.

Seven-try South Africa crush Argentina to become champions

Full-back Apehele Fassi and flanker Pieter-Steph du Toit scored two tries each as South Africa trounced Argentina 48-7 in Mbombela on Saturday to win the Rugby Championship.

Argentina, who trailed 27-7 at half-time, paid dearly for ill-discipline. Flanker Pablo Matera received a red card and brothers Mateo and Santiago Carreras were both sin-binned.

Malcom Marx and centre Jesse Kriel also crossed the tryline for the Springboks, whose only previous title in the competition came five years ago.

Scrum-half Jaden Hendrikse, a surprise choice as goal-kicker, slotted two conversions and a penalty. Substitute playmaker Handre Pollard kicked three

conversions.

Fly-half Tomas Albornoz scored all the Argentine points as he converted his own try before a capacity 45,000 crowd at Mbombela Stadium.

South Africa completed the six-round southern hemisphere championship with 24 points. Then came outgoing title-holders New Zealand (16 points), Argentina (14) and Australia (five).

Nine-time winners New Zealand completed a disappointing

campaign with a 33-13 victory over Australia in Wellington earlier on Saturday.

Before the match in Mbombela the spotlight was on two Springboks -- lock Eben Etzebeth and fly-half Manie Libbok -- for different reasons.

Etzebeth became the most-capped Springbok with 128 Test appearances, edging ahead of fellow lock Victor Matfield, who retired in 2015 after playing in 127 internationals.
