

Barbar fishermen demand long-overdue port, propose urgent safety measures and clean-up

ishermen in Barbar are facing theft and hazardous waterways, calling for urgent action to safeguard their livelihoods and ensure safe access to the sea.

"Every time I set out, I wonder if my boat will still be there when I return," said Jameel Shuaib, a fisherman who has incurred substantial losses due to stolen gear. "The sea is already risky enough without the added worry of thieves."

Local fishermen are demanding safety measures, citing frequent theft of boats and equipment alongside dangerous conditions in the local waterways.

They are urging the installation of security cameras to frustration over ongoing neglect. the marine channel and improving access roads to the pier.



Germany to evacuate diplomats' families from Israel, Lebanon

¬ ermany said yesterday Tit would withdraw diplomats' families and reduce staffing at its missions in Israel, Lebanon and the West Bank after the killing of Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah by Israel.

In a statement the foreign ministry said its crisis cell had met on Saturday to discuss "the highly tense situation in Lebanon and the wider region after the latest attacks" and had decided "to raise the crisis level for the missions in Beirut, Ramallah and Tel Aviv".

"In concrete terms this means that family members of personnel posted there will leave and travel to a safe location in the region or in Germany," the ministry said.

It added that "posted personnel will be thinned out, while taking care to ensure that the missions will still be able to carry out the full range of their work".

Germany currently has travel warnings in place for its citizens for Israel, Lebanon and the Palestinian territories.

Ensuring Road Safety in Bahrain

The past 26 years, and in my view, it is the most beautiful country in the world. My children were born and raised here, and have studied here all their lives.

When I first came to Bahrain, the population was hardly around 1.2 million. There were no malls, no parks, nothing—but look at how rapidly it has grown! Back then, people used to drive very carefully and slowly. However, in recent years, traffic has significantly increased, and now it seems everyone is in a hurry to go—where, I do not know. Unfortunately, this rush is leading to a rising number of fatal accidents, despite the installation of cameras to monitor speeding and red-light violations.

I have also noticed children leaning out of car windows, which has caused tragic incidents of children falling out, resulting in injuries, permanent disabilities, or even death. Who is to blame for these avoidable tragedies? Is it the drivers or the parents? To make matters worse, these incidents occur while the vehicles are moving at speeds of up to 100 km/h. Despite repeated warnings from traffic officers, many drivers still fail to follow basic safety rules. Children continue to sit on the front seat or, shockingly, on the driver's lap—whether it's the mother or the father—completely disregarding the dangers. Sudden braking can easily cause injury to the child.

I would like to request the authorities to take strict action against drivers who allow their windows to remain open while driving, especially when children are in the car. Furthermore, children sitting in the front seat should be strictly prohibited and drivers fined for violating this rule. In some countries, even members of the public are allowed to take pictures of drivers with children in unsafe positions and send them to the traffic department. A similar measure could be adopted here in Bahrain.

I believe that if such initiatives are implemented, we can reduce the number of accidents and injuries, making our roads safer and allowing us all to drive with greater peace of mind. God bless this nation and keep it safe. Jude Vyland

Government opposes bill linking non-Bahraini CPR card validity to residency duration

A bill seeking to tie the validity of the Central Population Registry (CPR) card to residency duration has encountered resistance from the government, which maintains that existing laws adequately address the issue without the need for new legislation.

The government expressed reservations regarding this parliamentary initiative, which aims to tighten control over irregular labour and restrict access to government and banking services, with the intention of enhancing financial returns to the public purse.

In its explanatory note, the government argues that the bill is unnecessary, stating, "There is no doubt that the legislator formulates legal rules to establish new provisions for a perceived benefit, not merely to reaffirm existing meanings and provisions."

Now that Indemnity is taking months to process instead of 7 days, expats should be granted a banking extension (until LMRA releases dues). Without residency, you can't use your account after 30 days. How do you get indemnity? The system isn't working.

Voyage Of Discovery

Those seeking for this bill should also understand that CPR is not a citizenship card or passport. Expatriates are not enemies of the Kingdom but contributors to the growth of the Kingdom of Bahrain. Laws should be made to accommodate not to put people in disarray. I hail the government for upholding the fundamental human right and her understanding that circumstances can change as life isn't straitforward sometimes. Nobody's finances should be locked up because his visa expired.

BEDFORD, Ohio (AP) — An 8-year-old girl took an SUV from her Ohio home and drove for miles to a store where she was later found unharmed, authorities said.

The girl, whose name was not released, and the vehicle – a 2020 Nissan Rogue – were reported missing around 9 a.m. Sunday, Bedford police said. Family members said they had last seen the girl at the residence about two hours earlier. As police launched an investigation, they learned a small child had been spotted driving a vehicle on a nearby road, but that vehicle could not be located. The SUV eventually was found a short time later in the parking lot of a Target store in Bainbridge, which is nearly 13 miles (21 kilometers) from her home.

Police soon found the child by herself inside the store. She told officers she had struck a mailbox while driving, but nothing else. Authorities did not say why she had decided to travel to the store or provide further details about her trip. The girl is too young to be charged criminally, police said. It wasn't clear Monday if any charges would be filed in the matter, which remains under investigation.
